# TOP OF THE LIST THIS ISSUE - VACCINATIONS

- The importance of vaccinations cannot be ignored.
- From babies to the more mature, vaccinations are vital to the control of many illnesses.
- You may think they are unnecessary. If so, think again!
- If you or your child is thought to be at risk from a vaccination it will not be offered to you. So, if you are asked to come for a 'jab' please don't turn it down.
- **CHECK THIS OUT**: Data on vaccinations published by NHS England shows that 16% of children who turned 5 between 1 April 2023 and 31 March 2024 had not received both doses of the MMR vaccination. Cases of measles increased to worrying levels.

**CHILDREN's vaccinations...** are given at 8 weeks, 12 weeks, 16 weeks, 1 year, 3 years 4 mths, 12 to 13 years and 14 years. It is important that children receive ALL of them.

#### Don't forget. Don't miss out. ADULTS' vaccinations are offered for flu, shingles, Covid, respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), Pneumococcal – and also selective immunisation programmes for pregnant women or individuals with underlying medical conditions.

# SICK NOTES...New Policy...

- 1. On your device search Fosse Medical Centre and enter the website.
- 2. On front page you will see a section stating 'Fit/Sick Notes', please click this.
- 3. The next page will show you which sick note you will need based on the current length of your sickness.
- 4. For 0-7 days, click on the link in that section which will provide you with a copy of the self-certify form.
- 5. For over 7 days, click on the link under 'Want to obtain a sick note?' and fill in the form with the relevant information that you require on your sick note.

PLEASE NOTE: Sick note requests can only be taken under this format.

If you need a downstairs appointment remember to mention this when booking the date.

## **Travelling Abroad?**

If you are visiting a country where you must have proof of vaccination don't leave it too late to book an appointment. Contact Reception at least 8 weeks before travel to ensure that the surgery has the necessary vaccines and that your body is able to develop immunity.

You can pick up a form from Reception There will be a charge for this service.

## CARE QUALITY COMMISSION (CQC) Report on its Recent Inspection

The CQC inspection team was very thorough in its work. Some of the actions undertaken on inspection were:

- Two hours with the clinical teams regarding audits, prescribing, safeguarding and consultation records to name but a few.
- Two hours with the Practice Manager regarding safe staffing levels, contracts, and training.
- Two hours with the nursing staff regarding cleaning protocols, audits, long term conditions (asthma, diabetes, COPD)
- One hour with Klair, Reception Manager, regarding Staff training, support and rotas, and patient feedback.

The feedback from the inspectors at the end of the day was very positive, especially in relation to how everyone at Fosse Medical Centre worked closely as a team and the emphasis on patient safety. Every area of the inspection was rated GOOD.

## REMEMBER...PHARMACY FIRST... can

**give certain prescription medications directly without seeing a GP**. After a consultation with the pharmacist the Pharmacy will send a notification to the patient's GP on the same day or on the following working day. Pharmacists have private consultation rooms and you do not always need an appointment.

## ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

As has been mentioned in many Newsletters, Fosse Medical Centre will not tolerate any form of abuse of staff or premises. If anyone is guilty of abuse they will be given 8 days to find a new surgery. After that time they will no longer be able to use Fosse Medical Centre.

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
