Vaccinations – Again!

We would like to say 'It is never too late for vaccinations, but sometimes it is. Flu, measles, COVID – can all be killers. Vaccination is the safest and best means of prevention. We all owe it to ourselves and our families to do our best and get them all vaccinated at the appropriate time.

- <u>FLU</u> For children aged between 2 and 3 years the vaccination will be available from mid-September
- <u>FLU and RSV</u> For those over 65 years will be available from 1 October. (Note: the last date this can be given is 31 March next year.)
- **HPV** For 15 year olds
- <u>COVID</u> For COVID jabs you may need to find a Pharmacy or Health Centre that is giving these, or look at the NHS websites for details of places near you that are vaccinating against COVID. If over 75 or immuno-suppresed you can:
 - book on the NHS App
 - online at www.nhs.uk/book-covid
 - or go to www.nhs.uk/covid-walk-in to find a walk-in site near you

REMINDERS...

- **NEW PATIENTS...**All new patients must have a *New Patient Health Check*. If you fail to turn up for the appointment or fail to let the surgery know that you cannot attend you may not be registered with FMC.
- DOWNSTAIRS APPOINTMENTS... If you would like your appointment to be downstairs please mention this when booking your appointment.
- **PRESCRIPTIONS...** You may have a nominated Pharmacy to which your prescriptions will be sent for your collection, **OR**, if you have a paper prescription, written by the Doctor, you can take it to any Pharmacy although they may not be able to provide your medication immediately.

MOUNJARO IS IN THE NEWS...

In view of the doubling in price of the weight loss jab new guidelines have been given regarding the prescribing of Mounjaro. Type 2 diabetics must have a BMI of 35 or more for Mounjaro to be prescribed and only cases of obesity will qualify for the product on prescription, not purely for weight loss.

PHARMACY FIRST...

We have written about this before but it is always worth reminding patients that our PHARMACIES can provide excellent advice on such things as ***** Ear Infections (1-17 years) ***** Shingles (18 and over) ***** Sore throats (5 and over) ***** Sinusitis (18 and over) ***** Impetigo (1 year and over). Patients phoning the surgery, 111 or going to urgent care settings with the above symptoms will be referred to a Pharmacy. If the Pharmacy is unable to help it will ask you to contact your Doctor.

- ❖ Pharmacies also provide support for the following: Healthy Eating ❖ Stopping Smoking ❖ Monitoring Blood Pressure ❖ Contraception ❖ Exercise.
- ❖ In some cases Pharmacies can provide prescription medications without the need to see a GP. After a consultation with a Pharmacist a notification will be sent to the patient's GP on the same or following day.
- ❖ Pharmacists are also experienced in spotting warning signs, also known as red flag symptoms, which may warrant a referral to another healthcare provider.
